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ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Students eligible for this scholarship must:

- Be of African American or African descent and at least one of the following:
 - Morris, Sussex, Warren or Hunterdon County resident
 - Morris, Sussex, Warren or Hunterdon County high school senior
 - Active participant in one of Morrystown Alumnae Chapter's youth programs
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale
- Have been accepted to an accredited two-year or four-year college or university
- Agree to be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee as part of the selection process

Application Procedures

1. Application

This application must be complete and **typed** in order to be considered. Handwritten applications will not be considered. Include additional pages if necessary.

2. Official Transcript

An official high school transcript of grades covering all years of high school with cumulative GPA. The transcript **MUST** be sent in a sealed envelope. The transcript may come directly from the school but must be postmarked by the deadline or your application will be considered incomplete and will not be reviewed.

3. Essay

Compose and submit your personal essay on a separate sheet of paper. **Essay must be typed**. Hand-written submissions will not be accepted and will render the application incomplete.

4. Letters of Recommendation

Two (2) letters of recommendation are required:

- One letter must be from a school administrator or faculty member (i.e., teacher, guidance counselor, principal, coach, etc.) and be written on school letterhead.
- The other letter must come from a supervisor of a community-based volunteer organization and should detail your community service activities. The community service/volunteer organization letter must be submitted on the organization's letterhead (not school letterhead).
- Letters of recommendation must be submitted in sealed envelopes. They may either accompany your application or be sent under separate cover but must be postmarked by the deadline.

5. Application Timeline

Your application, sealed transcript, sealed letters of recommendation, and essay **must be sent via U.S. mail and postmarked on or before April 15**. Materials postmarked after April 15 will render your application incomplete. Faxed or emailed documents will not be accepted.
